## Quarterly Meeting of the George Lake Rehabilitation District Friday, February 6, 2004

### **Call to Order:**

7:00pm, Secretary - Pearl Seavitte absent (substituted by Steve Kuksa), all other members present.

### **Approval of Minutes:**

Motion to accept Quarterly Meeting of Nov. 14, 2003 by Fred Ekornaas, 2<sup>nd</sup> – Rich Gossling.

Motion to accept Board Meeting of Dec. 18, 2003 by Rich Gossling, 2<sup>nd</sup> – Jeff Coultrip.

### **Treasurers Report:**

A money market account deposit in the amount of \$7,988.95 was added to the report, motion to accept by Fred Ekornaas, 2<sup>nd</sup> – Bob Chudy.

### **Proposed Parking at Boat Launch Ramp:**

Rich Gossling and Ernie Chiodo met with DNR representative Heidi Hopkins for inspections. Heidi indicates no DNR permit is necessary and will submit a letter indicating approval. Recap: Parking spaces will be constructed for 5 vehicles including trailers plus 1 handicap space, 300' long by 10' wide in gravel form parallel to the road south of 106<sup>th</sup> Street under sided with a culvert. Cost expected to be \$5,000.00 – available grants for project to be researched and applied for as accordingly.

### **Appoint Auditing Committee:**

A 2003 audit is needed for Jan. 1 through Dec. 31, 2003. It was determined that the same committee who audited 2002 performs this duty consisting of: Sam Seavitte, Lisa laquinta, & Tobie Nichols. Charlotte Burns also volunteered for the committee.

### **Committee Reports:**

Weed Control/Harvesting: The property where the harvester is stored during off-season has been sold, removal requested to be in April or longer.

Watershed: Three more samples will be taken for the plant study grant after ice thaws and presence of water movement is available.

Lake Monitoring: No report available.

Special Projects: No report available. It was suggested that the secretary send a letter to the committee to request a report be submitted.

Grants: No further information available at this time.

### **Lake Aquatic Plant Management Grant Update:**

Kathy Aron of Aron & Associates supplied copies of the final plan and discussed in detail all revisions, explanations, concerns, corrections, and clarifications. This plan is final now and motion to accept by Fred Ekornaas, 2<sup>nd</sup> – Jeff Coultrip. This plan is available to the public at the town website -

### **Old Business:**

It was recommended that an additional line item be supplied to the budget for the proposed parking construction. Bob Koba previously mentioned he had given away a dredger, this dredger has now been found to be unavailable. Funds for fish stocking in 2004 was motioned for acceptance by Jeff Coultrip, 2<sup>nd</sup> – Rich Gossling.

### **New Business:**

The guard rail on 101<sup>st</sup> Street is slated for replacement; Randy Kerkman is open for suggestions, discussions, and ideas. Measures to replace or modify the blue cylinders at the beach area will be underway to help prevent vehicle access and driving onto the lake and ice during Winters. A special meeting would be arranged for the payment of the parking construction.

### **Citizen Comments:**

Bill Blazich mentioned that ice fishing reports on George Lake have been posted and exposed on the website <http://www.lake-link.com> which could account for increased traffic and activity on George Lake, as well as illegal driving of vehicles onto the lakes ice.

### **Adjournment:**
