

Board Meeting of the George Lake Rehabilitation District

Thursday, December 18, 2003

Meeting called to order at 7:30pm

All Board members present

Reviewed and made recommendations on Lake Plant Management draft submitted by Aron and Associates. The draft was reviewed page by page with comments and questions to be answered by Kathy Aron. The secretary will send these comments to Kathy Aron and ask her to respond before the February 2004 meeting at which time the Board would like to accept the Lake Plant Management Study.

Fred Ekornaas suggested copies of the Study be made and mailed to all Lake residents. This would be too costly and time consuming. When the final Study is approved, we will ask Kathy Aaron to provide a disk and we will have the Town Office put the entire study on the George Lake web site. A few copies can be made available at the Town Office and the next Newsletter in the spring will have information about the Study.

Rich Gossling discussed the sewer treatment plant. SEWRPC suggestion is to go to Kenosha for sewer. This would increase the sewer bills 70%. Citizens can still have input with this decision.

Rich Gossling received a letter from the DNR. George Lake does not have adequate public access. Public parking by the boat launch for 5 vehicles and trailers needs to be provided or George Lake could lose their grants. The town of Bristol will put in a 3<sup>rd</sup> lane only for parking along 106<sup>th</sup> street. This would be 300 ft. of parallel parking including a handicap parking place. The cost would be \$5000. The Board will ask Randy Kerkman to attend the February meeting to provide a sketch of the proposed parking area, describe this area and answer questions. The Board will need to take action on this proposal at the February meeting.

New letterhead for George Lake was approved. Thank you Steve Kuksa.
