Regular Town Board Minutes  
September 8, 2008

*The notice for the regular semi-monthly meeting of the Bristol Town Board had been posted at the Municipal Building, Bristol Post Office, Benson's Corners, Woodworth Post Office, and the Town Website on September 5, 2008. The agenda was faxed to Rainbow Manor the Kenosha News, Westosha Report, and the Bulletin on that date.*

1. The meeting of the Bristol Town Board was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Richard Gossling. In attendance at the meeting were Supervisors Atwood, Murphy-Fisch, Owens and McCabe, Administrator Randy Kerkman, Clerk/Treasurer Amy Klemko, and four constituents.
2. Chairman Gossling led in the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
3. Approval of Agenda: A motion was made by Supervisor Atwood and was seconded by Supervisor Murphy-Fisch to approve the agenda. The motion was carried unanimously.
4. Approval of the minutes of the August 25, 2008 Regular Town Board Meeting. A motion was made by Supervisor McCabe and was seconded by Supervisor Owens to approve the minutes of the August 25, 2008 Regular Town Board Meeting. The motion was carried unanimously.
5. Clerk/Treasurer's Report: A motion was made by Supervisor Murphy-Fisch and was seconded by Supervisor Atwood to receive and file the treasurer's report written by Clerk/Treasurer Amy Klemko showing \$11,362,538.93 as the cash and investment balance. The motion was carried unanimously.
6. Approval of Bills: A motion was made by Supervisor Atwood and was seconded by Supervisor Murphy-Fisch to approve the bills. Supervisor Owens had questions regarding alternate Plan Commission members being paid for sitting in the audience at planning meetings and requested that this be placed on the next agenda for full board discussion. The motion was carried unanimously.
7. Citizen's Comments:  
Shirley Davidson commented that the lack of attendance at the meeting was because everyone is up at the county meeting looking for support in getting the speed limit reduced, mainly on Wilmot Road and other county roads. She stated that the board had passed a resolution on to the county on this matter and if there is anything else they can do to help, please do so.
8. Chairman's Comments: None.

9. Supervisor's Comments:

Supervisor Atwood commented about the meeting at the county center tonight. Supervisor Murphy-Fisch also commented on the county meeting tonight. Supervisor Owens stated that she fully supports this and will do whatever we can to get the speed limits reduced on highway C as something needs to be done. Supervisor McCabe stated that he also attended the meeting tonight and told what the town has done regarding a survey and traffic study. He also asked for a copy of the counties traffic study that was done. He asked that our sheriff put a little more emphasis on patrolling highway C as he has gotten complaints about the speeding and passing on the double yellow lines on the hill east of highway D. He also stated that two meetings ago he asked about a written procedure for citizen's to be placed on the agenda and if anything has been done. Chairman Gossling stated that he sent a letter to Mr. Kordecki because he also had a request on this, that we have been going according to past practices, and the reason it hasn't been discussed is because it is being addressed in the new code of ordinances and will be taken care of at that time.

The motion was carried unanimously.
