2. New Business:
 - a. Consider for approval the request of Bob Bingen (agent) for Michels Materials 817 W. Main Street, PO Box 128, Brownsville, WI 53006 requesting a Rezoning from PR-1 (Park and Recreational District) to A-2 (General Agricultural District) on tax parcel #35-4-121-364-0100 and a Conditional Use Permit for a temporary concrete batch plant for the paving of I94. This property is part of the SE ¼ and PT NE ¼ SEC 36 T1 R21 BEG ON S LN SE ¼ 600.7FT W OF SE COR TH W ALG S LN 729.8 FT TO W LN E ½ TH N ALG W LN 2675 FT TO N LN ¼ TH N ALG W LN SE ¼ OF NE ¼ 1325.36 FT TO N LN ¼ TH E 1051.34 FT TO W ROW I94 Town of Bristol, Kenosha County, Wisconsin. For informational purposes this property is located at 12700 120th Avenue, Kenosha, WI 53142 (Bristol Township) adjacent to the Bristol Renaissance Faire.
