Regular Town Board Minutes
October 26, 2009

The notice for the regular semi-monthly meeting of the Bristol Town Board had been posted at the Municipal Building, Bristol Post Office, Benson's Corners, Woodworth Post Office, and the Town Website on October 23, 2009. The agenda was faxed to Rainbow Manor the Kenosha News, and the Westosha Report on that date.

1. The meeting of the Bristol Town Board was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Richard Gossling. In attendance at the meeting were Supervisors Atwood, Fisch, Owens and McCabe, Administrator Randy Kerkman, Clerk/Treasurer Amy Klemko, Chief Peter Parker and eight constituents.
2. Chairman Gossling led in the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
3. Approval of Agenda: A motion was made by Supervisor McCabe and was seconded by Supervisor Owens to approve the agenda. The motion was carried unanimously.
4. Approval of the minutes of the October 12, 2009 Regular Town Board Meeting and the October 14, 2009 Budget Workshop.
A motion was made by Supervisor Atwood and was seconded by Supervisor Fisch to approve the minutes of the October 12, 2009 Regular Town Board Meeting. The motion was carried with 4 Ayes and Supervisor Owens abstaining because she was absent.
A motion was made by Supervisor McCabe and was seconded by Supervisor Fisch to approve the minutes of the October 12, 2009 Budget Workshop. The motion was carried with 4 Ayes and Supervisor Owens abstaining because she was absent.
5. Clerk/Treasurer's Report: A motion was made by Supervisor Atwood and was seconded by Supervisor Fisch to receive and file the treasurer's report written by Clerk/Treasurer Amy Klemko showing \$8,513,670.45 as the cash and investment balance. The motion was carried unanimously.
6. Approval of Bills: A motion was made by Supervisor Fisch and was seconded by Supervisor Atwood to approve the bills. The motion was carried unanimously.

8. Chairman's Comments: Chairman Gossling reminded everyone to come out and vote November 3.

15. Unfinished Business:
 - a. A motion was made by Supervisor Atwood and was seconded by Supervisor Owens to remove the parking for mainstreet from the table. The motion was carried unanimously.
Doris Magwitz feels the town should enforce the snow ordinance, enforce parking on mainstreet to 1.5 spaces per resident and have parking in the town hall lot or across the street from the town hall in the fenced in area.
A motion was made by Supervisor McCabe and was seconded by Supervisor Owens to send a letter to the local businesses asking them to park in the town hall parking lot or areas designated by Administrator Kerkman. The motion was carried unanimously.
A motion was made by Supervisor Fisch and was seconded by Supervisor Atwood to institute alternate parking from 10:00 p.m – 6:00 a.m. on snow days. The motion was carried unanimously.

16. New Business:
 - a. A motion was made by Supervisor Owens and was seconded by Supervisor McCabe to approve the following operator's license request for Rochelle Mayfield pending Sheriff's Department records check. The motion was carried unanimously.
