1. Chairman Gossling led in the Pledge of Allegiance.
2. The Town of Bristol 2010 Budget Hearing was called to order at 7:00 p.m. In attendance at the meeting were Supervisors Atwood, Fisch, and McCabe. Administrator Randy Kerkman, Clerk/Treasurer Amy Klemko, Finance Director Kathie Gerretsen, Fire Chief Peter Parker, Auditor Renee Messing of Clifton Gunderson and nine residents. Supervisor Owens was excused.
3. Renee Messing gave the presentation of the 2010 Town General Budget, Fire/Rescue, Recycling and Debt Service Budgets.
4. Citizen's Comments:
Shirley Davidson asked if the village residents will get to approve a village budget eventually. Administrator Kerkman and Renee Messing stated that it will probably come automatically, that the budget was made to divide assets and liabilities with an incorporation intergovernmental agreement.
5. Chairman Gossling closed the public hearing at 7:20 p.m.
6. A motion was made by Supervisor Atwood and was seconded by Supervisor Fisch to adjourn the Budget Hearing at 7:20 p.m. The motion was carried unanimously.
7. Chairman Gossling called to order the Special Town Meeting of the Electors of the Town of Bristol pursuant to Section 60.121(1)(c) of the Wisconsin Statutes.
 - a. A motion was made by John Boldt and was seconded by Bill Glembocki to approve the total 2010 highway expenditures pursuant to Section 81.01(3) of the Wisconsin Statutes. The motion was carried with 16 Ayes and 0 Nays.
 - b. A motion was made by John Boldt and was seconded by Shirley Davidson to adopt the 2010 Town Tax Levy. The motion was carried with 16 Ayes and 0 Nays.
8. The Special Town Meeting of the Electors was adjourned at 7:23 p.m.
